Dear Parents, Students, Staff, and Community Members,

Due to multiple known cases of COVID-19 affecting our school, evidence of wide community spread happening in the Katahdin Region, and out of an abundance of caution; Opal Myrick and Schenck High School will shift to remote learning for the week of Monday, April 12th. Our schools will resume in-person for all students on Monday, April 26th.

All close contacts to positive cases affecting our school have been notified.

Opal Myrick students can work on the emergency/snow day materials provided to them by their teacher on Monday, April 12th. Teachers will put together additional learning materials and prepare student computers on Monday morning. **Computers and Learning materials can be picked up on Monday, April 12th from 12 to 2 pm outside of our building.**

Schenck High School students will follow their current schedules and be able to stream their classes live. All work will be done on Google Classroom. The SAT administration scheduled for Tuesday for juniors will be postponed. We will communicate with an alternative plan for the SAT at a later date.

Region III students will also be remote the week of the 12th and will resume in-person on the 26th.

Sports teams and those participating in Performing Arts activities at Schenck and Stearns will not practice in-person the week of April 12th. We hope to resume these activities the week of Monday, April 19th. However, this is yet to be determined.

The Kindergarten registration scheduled for April 12th will now be done by phone. Please contact Kim Lyons on Monday April 12th for more information and instructions.

Bag Lunches will be available by request and can be picked up each day between 11 am and 12 pm at the doors on the side of the cafeteria. Please call our main office at 746-3511 **by 10 am** to request these services.

We asked that you protect yourself during this time period by mask wearing, social distancing, and handwashing and we thank you for your understanding and patience. We truly appreciate your support in helping keep all of students, staff, and our community members safe.
